RI General Price List Survey: September, 2010

Introduction

The Funeral Consumers Alliance of Rhode Island (FCA-RI) was formed in 1980 (under the name Memorial Society of Rhode Island), was revitalized in 2007, and adopted its current name in 2009. The organization seeks, among its other activities, to provide accurate information regarding burial/cremation and to encourage well-informed pre-planning of these events.

This Rhode Island General Price List Survey (GPL) of 2010 presents cost comparisons related to burial or cremation among vendors in Rhode Island. We have made every effort to be as accurate and as consistent as possible. We welcome any corrections that are appropriate and will make these changes on our website: <http://www.funerals.org/affiliates/rhodeisland/>.

We have tried in every instance to offer a consistent basis for comparison, e.g., a uniform standard of four hours for viewing and funeral home settings for funeral and memorial services. To avoid misunderstanding, and because prices may change without notice, we recommend that consumers always consult with individual vendors before finalizing any arrangements. Note that the date entered below a funeral vendor's name is the date of the GPL used in compiling this survey.

The Funeral Rule for General Price Lists (GPL)

Complying with the Funeral Rule, a Federal Trade Commission publication to help funeral directors, clarifies who is entitled to a GPL:

“You must give the General Price List to anyone who asks, in person, [emphasis supplied] about funeral goods, funeral services, or the prices of such goods or services. You must give a GPL to all persons who inquire about funeral arrangements. This may include competitors, journalists, and representatives of businesses, religious societies, government agencies, or consumer groups. The triggering event for giving out the GPL is a face-to-face meeting. The face-to-face meeting can occur anywhere, not just at the funeral home.”

Complying with the Funeral Rule,
Federal Trade Commission, June 2004, p.4

The Funeral Rule, enacted by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) on April 30, 1984, dictates what information must be included on the General Price List required of all funeral directors. A GPL must include specific categories of services, options open to the buying public and specific disclosures regarding the services and options provided. Additional information not required by law may also be included. We note that the General Price Lists provided to FCA-RI for this Survey range from one-page handouts to more lavish folders and booklets. Accuracy and adherence to the Funeral Rule are more important than these formal distinctions.

General Price List Survey

To simplify comparisons among funeral homes, we present all funeral homes in alphabetical order within discrete geographical areas. The survey, conducted from February through August, 2010, comprises information available to consumers on GPLs from Rhode Island funeral directors in accordance with the Funeral Rule. Definitions of the common terms used in the Survey are listed in the table at the end of this Summary.

Arrangements cited in this Survey may not always be the least costly in a category of service. For example, funerals or memorial services staged outside a funeral home *may* be a less expensive option than what we have included in our survey. Many funeral directors have also created special packages which may be good value.

Although many of the GPLs we collected were in compliance with the Funeral Rule, many others were, to one degree of significance or another, non-compliant. We note here *examples* of these infractions, which we do not discuss directly in our survey. (We do note missing information.) This list is *not* all-inclusive. It will, however, suggest areas of caution for the consumer and will provide the basis of follow-up activity by the FCA-RI.

<i>Complying with the Funeral Rule</i>	<i>Our Findings</i>
“The General Price List should be printed or typewritten....”	In our 2008 survey, one funeral home presented a form on which prices were handwritten; another presented a form on which earlier prices had been crossed out by hand and new information entered.
“The Rule also requires...six disclosures on...General Price List. These disclosures discuss...right to select only the goods and services desired...embalming...alternative containers for direct cremation...basic services fee and information on casket and outer burial container prices.”	One funeral home presented a “Statement of Funeral Goods and Services Selected” which contained no disclosures. Others submitted statements headed “General Price List” that contained no disclosures.
“The Rule requires you to itemize the prices for certain goods and services...” (See categories on Survey, most of which are mandated.)	Sometimes one category, e.g., graveside service, is missing, and sometimes many categories are missing. Sometimes a charge is not entered separately but is bundled together with fees for other services. Sometimes a crematory fee is not included. Some prices seem improbably high and wholly beyond those of other vendors.

Consumers must, as with any purchase, be careful to understand the various categories of services so that, for example, they avoid double payment for a single service and understand clearly what an actual purchase entails. For example, the receiving or transferring of remains between two funeral homes does not include possible flight costs, and cemetery expenses are not included in our survey.

The Funeral Consumers Alliance of Rhode Island recommends pre-planning (not to be confused with pre-paying) so that one can make clear business decisions in advance, free of the emotional turmoil which often accompanies grief. We also recommend consulting the government booklet upon which we rely, *Complying with the Funeral Rule*, Federal Trade Commission, June 2004, available free on-line at <http://www.ftc.gov/bcp/edu/pubs/business/adv/bus05.shtm>.

FCA-RI realizes, without judgment, that individual taste and means will determine the sorts of arrangements that members will choose. Our survey, nonetheless, enables people to select economical arrangements for disposition of the deceased. Visits to individual establishments will further permit consumers to observe first-hand the range of styles offered by different funeral directors.

We note once again: consumers should, in every instance, check both prices and services with those funeral directors whose services they are considering.

In our survey, we include the following categories:

Term	Definition from <i>Complying with the Funeral Rule</i>
Basic Service Fee	“... should cover services that are common to virtually all forms of disposition or arrangements that you offer”
Embalming	Cost generally includes use of preparation room, professional services, equipment, materials involved. Specific disclosure required for compliance.
Other Preparation of the Body	“... should include such services as cosmetic work to prepare the deceased for viewing”
Viewing	Cost is figured uniformly for four hours of visitation at a funeral home
Funeral Ceremony	“charge ... for ... a commemorative service with the body present, at the funeral home ...”
Transferring Remains (from place of death to the funeral home)]	Cost is generally a flat fee.
Hearse	Cost is generally a flat fee.
Limousine	Cost is generally a flat fee.
Graveside Service	The assumption is made that funeral and graveside services are distinct events. Consumer should clarify this
Total Full Service Funeral (without the cost of a casket)	Total of costs for all services cited above
Lowest Priced Casket	Cost may be a specific entry or be obvious from a full casket list.
Lowest Priced Vault (Outer Burial Container)	Cost may be a specific entry or be obvious from a full casket list.
Immediate Burial (without cost of casket – casket provided by consumer)	Cost of services and cost of any alternate burial containers required. We cite cost with a casket provided independently by the consumer.
Direct Cremation (with alternative container provided by funeral home)	Cost of services and cost of any alternate containers required. We cite cost with a container provided by the funeral home.
Memorial Service	“charge ... for ... a commemorative service <i>without</i> the body present” at the funeral home
Forwarding Remains (to another funeral home)	Cost should include all services involved, but does not include cost of related air or train travel.
Receiving Remains (from another funeral home)	Cost should include all services involved, but does not include cost of related air or train travel.
